RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, April 11, 2019, marks the 51st anniversary of the passage of the United States Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, which enunciated a National Policy of fair housing without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, familial status and disability; and

WHEREAS, the effective implementation of the National Policy depends on affirmative action at all levels of Government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Madison County Commission does hereby proclaim the month of April as Fair Housing Month in recognition of the importance of fair housing to our way of life; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Madison County Commission urges its citizens to obey the letter and the spirit of the Fair Housing Law as an expression of the individual rights guaranteed by the United States Constitution.


