

## Campground Rules:

- Only one authorized camping unit (RV, camper, etc) per site. Tent camping = 2 tent limit per site. Tents and campers must be on separate sites (no tent and camping unit on same site). Specific, numbered sites are NOT guaranteed. We will do our best to accommodate but cannot secure specific sites.
- All guests 20 years and younger must be accompanied by a legal guardian.
- All guests 18 and over must sign the guest registry.
- Park closes at Sunset. Keys to campground gate are available at host site.
- CHECKOUT IS 12:00 p.m.
- Campers are responsible for their lot and their guests. Please keep your lot clean and free of debris. Garbage should be placed in trash receptacle; tables should be kept on pads; and power cords and hoses should be kept off grass to allow for mowing.
- Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m. daily. All visitors must exit campground by 10:00 p.m. No excessive traffic in and out of gates.
- Do not park on grass - two vehicle limit per pad. Do not park on road. Park speed limit is 10 mph
- Off road vehicles, including but not limited to: four-wheelers, motorcycles, ATVs are not allowed on park grounds. Bicycles must have reflective devices and must be operated in safe manner. Golf carts may be used by disabled persons within the campground.
- Cleaning of laundry, dishes, and/or fish will not be allowed in restrooms.
- Pets are not allowed in or around buildings. Pets must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet and under owner's control. Clean up after pets.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed at Sharon Johnston Park. This includes the campground.
- Small fires are allowed in fire ring only. Please do not leave fires unattended and extinguish properly. Do not put ashes in garbage container.
- Disorderly conduct, use of profane language, or intoxication will not be tolerated and are grounds for dismissal from campground. Any person(s) causing a nuisance will be asked to vacate park.
- Drainage of water, soap, or grease or any other waste product onto the ground or into anything other than an approved holding tank or dumping station is a violation of state law.
- Please limit number of items placed on site that gives the appearance of being a permanent residence. NO digging around site or alterations of any kind. Campers may not add or construct structures of any kind to the lot. This includes, but is not limited to: decks, porches, light poles, storage units, etc.
- Violation of any rule is subject to evacuation by renter.
